**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)  
(No. 2) Ordinance, 1960**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. In section thirty-one of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") immediately after the words "sixty per centum of proof or" there are hereby inserted a comma and the words and a comma "otherwise than in stoppered bottles," Amendment to the principal Ordinance.

2. In section two of the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, the comma after the figures "1960" is hereby deleted and a full stop is hereby inserted therefor and all the words beginning with the words "and this Ordinance" to the end of that section are hereby deleted. Repeals.
