**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)
(No. 2) Ordinance, 1968**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, hereby order:—

1. The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:— Amend-
ments to
Ordinance of
1960.

- (a) in paragraph (d) of section twenty-six thereof, the comma after the word “demand” is deleted and the words “or to and by any other person with a meal” are repealed;
- (b) in the definition of the expression “a meal” in subsection (1) of section seventy-four thereof, the words “two shillings and six pence” are repealed and the words “seven shillings and six pence” are substituted therefor;

(c) in paragraph 1 of Part II of the Third Schedule thereto, the letters and figures "7 p.m.—9.30 p.m." are repealed and the letters and figures "7.30 p.m.—10.30 p.m." are substituted therefor.

Repeal.

2. Subsection (2) of section three of the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968, is hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1968.

(2) This Ordinance, the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968, and the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 to 1967, may be cited together as the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 to 1968.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of February, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.
