The Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1990

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of July, 1990(a), hereby order:—

Amendments to Ordinance of 1984

1. In the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1984(b), as amended(c) is hereby further amended as follows—

- (g) in section 129(a) for “fifty pounds” substitute “£80”;
- (h) in section 129(b) for “ten pounds” substitute “£16”;
- (i) in sections 130(c) and (d) for “ten pounds” substitute “£16”;
- (j) in section 131 for “ten pounds” substitute “£16”;
- (k) in section 132 for “fifty pounds” substitute “£80”;
- (l) in section 134 for “ten pounds” substitute “£16”;
- (m) in section 135 for “ten pounds” substitute “£16”;
- (n) in section 137(a) and (b) for “twenty-five pounds” substitute “£40”;
- (o) in section 142(1) for “five pounds” substitute “£8”;
- (p) in section 142(2) for “one pound” substitute “£2” and “five pounds” substitute “£8”;
- (q) in the definition of “a meal” in section 158 for “one pound” substitute “£3”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1990.
