**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment) No. 3  
Ordinance, 1951.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 20th day of June, 1951, hereby order:—

1. The Second Schedule to the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1948, is amended as follows:—

- (i) sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph 1, entitled "Hotel licences", of Part I of the said Schedule are hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraphs are substituted therefor—

"(a) winter period—10.30 a.m. – 2 p.m.

(2.30 p.m. if liquor served with a meal)

5 p.m. – 10 p.m. Monday – Friday

4 p.m. – 10 p.m. Saturday.";

“(b) summer period—10.30 a.m. – 2 p.m.  
(2.30 p.m. if liquor served with a meal)  
5 p.m. – 11 p.m. Monday – Friday  
4 p.m. – 11 p.m. Saturday.”;

(ii) paragraph 9 of Part I of the said Schedule is hereby repealed and the following paragraph substituted therefor—

“9. Guest House licences.

(a) winter period—10.30 a.m. – 2.30 p.m.  
5 p.m. – 10 p.m. Monday – Friday  
4 p.m. – 10 p.m. Saturday

(b) summer period—10.30 a.m. – 2.30 p.m.  
5 p.m. – 11 p.m. Monday – Friday  
4 p.m. – 11 p.m. Saturday.”

2. This Ordinance and the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1948 to 1951, may be cited together as the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1948 to 1951.

3. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou and shall come into force on the 21st day of October, 1951.
