**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)  
(No. 3) Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

Amend-  
ment to  
Ordinance  
of 1960.

1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section seventeen of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960, as amended (a), is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor—

“(b) pay to the Constables of the Parish concerned who have examined the premises

in respect of which the application is being made, the sum of two pounds.” 1971.

2. Section four of the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1971 (*b*), is hereby repealed. Repeal.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1971. Citation and collective title.

(2) This Ordinance, the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1971, and the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 to 1968, may be cited together as the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 to 1971.
