Ordinance of the Chief Pleas  
entitled

The Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1994

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 8 and 24 of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951(a), as amended, and with the approval of the Seigneur, hereby order:-

Amendment to General Provisions Ordinance.

1. In the Liquor Licensing (General Provisions) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979, as amended(b)-

(a) in the arrangement of sections insert the following entry at the appropriate place-

"22B. Conditions of exercise of Guest House Licence.";

(b) after section 22A insert the following section-

"Conditions of exercise of Guest House Licence.

22B. (1) A person holding a guest house licence in respect of any premises shall not sell or supply any intoxicating liquor or cause or permit any such liquor to be sold, supplied or consumed in the premises except-

(a) to and by a resident of the premises or to and by the guests of such a resident entertained by him at his own expense; and

- (b) Ordinance No. 57, amended by No.'s 62, 76B and 86.

(b) for consumption on the licensed premises.

(2) A person shall not consume any intoxicating liquor in any premises in respect of which there is a guest house licence except in the circumstances specified in subsection (1).";

(c) in section 46(1)(a)(i) and (b)(i) for "fifty pounds" substitute "level 2 on the Sark uniform scale";

(d) in section 46(1)(a)(ii) and (b)(ii) for "one hundred pounds" substitute "twice level 2 on the Sark uniform scale";

(e) in the First Schedule add the following entry at the appropriate place-

"5. Guest House Licence.;"

(f) in the Second Schedule(c) in Part I ("Weekdays other than Sundays") add the following entry-

5. Guest House Licence.	Summer	None	Midday to 3.30 p.m. 6.30 p.m. to 11.45 p.m.
	Winter	None	Midday to 3.30 p.m. 6.30 p.m. to 11.45 p.m.

(c) The Second Schedule was substituted by Ordinance No. 76B and amended by No. 86.

Provided that during any of the aforesaid permitted hours of the summer and winter periods the intoxicating liquor shall be served with a meal.";

- (g) in the said Second Schedule, in Part II ("Sundays") add the following entry-

5. Guest House Licence.	Summer	None	Midday to 3.30 p.m. 6.30 p.m. to 11.45 p.m.
	Winter	None	Midday to 3.30 p.m. 6.30 p.m. to 11.45 p.m.

Provided that during any of the aforesaid permitted hours of the summer and winter periods the intoxicating liquor shall be served with a meal.";

- (h) in Parts I and II of the said Second Schedule, for "2.30 p.m." wherever appearing in paragraphs 1 and 4 substitute "3.30 p.m."

**Amendment to Fees Ordinance.**

2. (1) In section 1 of the Liquor Licensing (Fees) (No. 2) (Sark) Ordinance, 1979, as amended(d)-

- (a) in item 1, for "£1.50" substitute "£3.00";

(d) Ordinance No. 59, amended by No. 76A.

- (b) in item 2, for "£18.00" substitute "£52.00";
- (c) in item 3, for "£5.00" substitute "£25.00";
- (d) in item 4, for "£15.00" substitute "£30.00";
- (e) after item 4 add the following entry-

"5. Guest House Licence. £30.00".

(2) In sections 2 and 3 of the said Ordinance, for "one pound" substitute "£3.00" and, in section 3, for "three pounds" substitute "£9.00".

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1994.
