**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1960**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960 (herein-after referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is hereby amended as follows:— Amend-ments to principal Ordinance.

- (a) in subsection (1) of section forty-two thereof a comma is hereby inserted immediately after the words “Restaurant Licence”, the word “or” is hereby deleted and the words “or Airport Licence” are hereby inserted immediately after the words “Beer Licence”;
- (b) immediately after the definition of “police officer” in subsection (1) of section seventy-four thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional definition:—

“ “the promulgated hours” means the hours for the time being promulgated by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration as being the hours in any day during which La Villiaze Airport is available for use;”;

- (c) in the First Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 11 there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph, numbered “12” :—

“12. Airport Licences.”;

- (d) in Part I of the Second Schedule thereto immediately below the words “Club Licence” in the left hand column thereof there are hereby inserted the words “Airport Licence” and in the right hand column thereof immediately below the symbol and figures “£15 0s. 0d.” there are hereby inserted the symbol and figures “£22 10s. 0d.”;

- (e) in Part I of the Third Schedule thereto immediately after paragraph 8 there is hereby inserted the following additional paragraph, numbered “9” :—

“9. Airport Licences

(a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—the end of the promulgated hours or 10 p.m. whichever time is the earlier.

(b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—the end of the promulgated hours or 11 p.m. whichever time is the earlier.

Provided that if, during any day or days, La Villiaze Airport is officially closed for flying by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration, a licensee who is the holder of an Airport Licence shall not exercise that licence during that period.”;

- (f) in paragraph 2 of Part III of the Third Schedule thereto the word “and” is hereby deleted and a comma is inserted therefor and immediately after the words “Beer Licences” there are hereby inserted the words “and Airport Licences” and immediately after the figures and letters “9.30 p.m.” there is hereby inserted the following Proviso:—

“ Provided that if, during any day or days, La Villiaze Airport is officially closed for flying by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration, a licensee who is the holder of an Airport Licence shall not exercise that licence during that period.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960. Citation and collective title.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty. Commencement.
