**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1963.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960, as amended, intoxicating liquor may, on the ninth day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, be sold, supplied and consumed in any premises in respect of which there is then in force a licence for the sale of such liquor, not being a Club-Licence, General Off-Licence or Beer Off-Licence, at any time after the hours during which the sale, supply and consumption of such liquor in such premises is permitted under those provisions until twelve o'clock midnight. Extension of permitted hours on 9th May, 1963.

2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou. Application.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963. Citation.
