**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1963**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") (a) is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) in paragraph (c) of section three thereof immediately before the word "cause" there are hereby inserted the words "unless there is already in force in respect of the premises concerned a liquor licence of the same category as that being applied for,";

- (b) in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (c) of section ten thereof the word "eight" is hereby repealed and the word "ten" is hereby substituted therefor and at the end of that sub-paragraph immediately after the word "servants" there are hereby inserted the following additional words—  
 "and at least two separate water closets one of which is to be reserved exclusively for female persons";
- (c) section ten thereof is hereby re-numbered as subsection (1) of section ten and immediately thereafter there are hereby inserted the following two additional subsections numbered "(2)" and "(3)"—
- "(2) In making any calculation for the purposes of sub-paragraphs (ii), (iii) or (iv) of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of this section, there shall not be taken into account any bedroom suite on the premises concerned.
- (3) In this section the expression "bedroom suite" means a bedroom in respect of which there is provided for the exclusive use of the occupant thereof a fixed bath or shower bath and a water closet, whether separate or otherwise.";
- (d) Part I of the Third Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Part set out in the First Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby substituted therefor;
- (e) in paragraph 3 of Part IV of the Third Schedule thereto the figures and letters—  
 " 9 a.m.—12.30 p.m.  
 2.30 p.m.—8 p.m."

are hereby deleted and the figures and letters "9 a.m.—8 p.m." are hereby substituted therefor;

- (f) the words "Guest House Licence" and "Guest House Licences" where those words occur therein are hereby repealed and the words "Residential Licence" and "Residential Licences" are hereby respectively substituted therefor.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section ten of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, the provisions of that sub-paragraph which were in force immediately before the coming into force of this Ordinance shall continue to have effect, in relation to premises in respect of which a valid Guest House Licence was held immediately before the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, on and after the coming into force of this Ordinance in all respects as if this Ordinance had not been passed. Saving.

(2) In this section the expression "Guest House Licence" means a Guest House Licence granted in pursuance of the principal Ordinance before the coming into force of this Ordinance.

3. The Ordinances set out in the left hand column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent set out in the right hand column of that Schedule. Repeals.

4. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963. Citation and collective title.

(2) This Ordinance and the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960, may be cited together as the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 and 1963.

- (a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—10.00 p.m. Monday—Friday  
10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m. Saturday
- (b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m.

## 2. Public Hall and Public House Licences

- (a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—10.00 p.m. Monday—Friday  
10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m. Saturday
- (b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m.

## 3. General Off-licences

9.00 a.m.— 8.00 p.m.

## 4. Beer Off-licences

9.00 a.m.—12.30 p.m.

2.30 p.m.— 8.00 p.m.

## 5. Beer Licences

- (a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—10.00 p.m. Monday—Friday  
10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m. Saturday
- (b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m.

## 6. Café Licences

- (a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—10.00 p.m. Monday—Friday  
 10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m. Saturday
- (b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m.

## 7. Restaurant Licences

- (a) winter period— midday —10.00 p.m. Monday—Friday  
 midday —11.00 p.m. Saturday
- (b) summer period— midday —11.00 p.m.

## 8. Residential Licences

- (a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—10.00 p.m. Monday—Friday  
 10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m. Saturday
- (b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m.

## 9. Airport Licences

- (a) winter period—10.30 a.m.—the end of the promulgated hours or 10.00 p.m. whichever time is the earlier.
- (b) summer period—10.30 a.m.—the end of the promulgated hours or 11.00 p.m. whichever time is the earlier.

Provided that if, during any day or days, La Villiaze Airport is officially closed for flying by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration, a licensee who is the holder of an Airport Licence shall not exercise that licence during that period."
