## Ordinance of the States **XXXIV**

1968

Made ... .. 25th September, 1968.

Coming into Operation ... 27th October, 1968.

### **The Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, and on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in subsection (1) of section twenty-five thereof all the words after the words “as the Royal Court may specify” to the end of that subsection are hereby repealed and the words “during hours additional to the hours referred to in the last preceding section, that is to say, until 11.30 p.m. to a person consuming a meal ordered before 11.00 p.m. so, however, that such liquor shall not be consumed after midnight.” are hereby substituted therefor;

- (b) the definition of the expression "summer period" in subsection (1) of section seventy-four thereof is hereby repealed;
- (c) Part I of the Third Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Part set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby substituted therefor.

Repeals.

2. Paragraph (d) of section one of, and the First Schedule to, the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963(b), are hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968.

(2) This Ordinance and the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 to 1967, may be cited together as the Liquor Licensing Ordinances, 1960 to 1968.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

Section one

PART I

*Weekdays other than Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and Good Friday*

1. Hotel Licences, Inn Licences, Public Hall Licences, Public House Licences, Beer Licences, Café Licences and Residential Licences.  
10.30 a.m.—11.00 p.m.
2. Restaurant Licences.  
Midday—11.00 p.m.
3. General Off-Licences.  
9.00 a.m.—8.00 p.m.

4. Beer Off-Licences.

9.00 a.m.—12.30 p.m.

2.30 p.m.—8.00 p.m.

5. Airport Licences.

10.30 a.m.—the end of promulgated hours  
or 11.00 p.m. whichever time  
is the earlier:

Provided that if, during any day or days,  
La Villiaze Airport is officially closed for  
flying by or on behalf of the States Board  
of Administration, a licensee who is the  
holder of an Airport Licence shall not  
exercise that licence during that period.”
