**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, on the representations of the  
Island Police Committee hereby order:—

1. Section thirty-seven of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960 as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, is hereby further amended by the insertion immediately after subsection (3) thereof of the following subsection—

“ (4) For the purposes of this section, the sale or purchase of tickets or the holding of a draw in any lottery made lawful by any Ordinance made under section two of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971, shall be deemed not to be the playing of a game of chance for stakes.”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971.
