**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (a) of section twenty-six of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1960, as amended (a), the semi-colon at the end thereof is deleted and a colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there are inserted the following additional words—

“Provided that for the purposes of this paragraph the expression “cinematograph show” shall not be deemed to include any cinematograph show organised by a club or a society;”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973. Citation.
