**The Liquor Licensing (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1992**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the
26th February, 1992(a), hereby order:-

Bar Meal permits.

1.(1) In the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1984(b)
as amended(c) ("the principal Ordinance") for "bar
lunch" "bar lunch certificate" and "bar lunch permit"
wherever the words appear, substitute "bar meal", "bar
meal certificate" and "bar meal permit" respectively.

(2) In section 64 of the principal Ordinance for
"between the hours of midday and thirty minutes after
two o'clock in the afternoon" substitute "between the
hours of 12 noon and 3.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. and 11.00
p.m.".

(3) For section 82(b) of the principal Ordinance, substitute -

"(b) otherwise than between the hours of 12 noon and 3.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. on any weekday other than Christmas Day or Good Friday."

holder of the Airport liquor
licence shall not sell or supply
or permit another person to sell
or supply intoxicating liquor -

(i) other than wines and spirits
in stoppered or sealed
containers, or

(ii) to any person for consumption
on the premises in respect of
which he holds the licence.

B. 10.00 a.m. - the end of
promulgated hours or
11.45 p.m., whichever
is earlier.

Permitted hours in respect of clubs.

3. For section 126 of the principal Ordinance, substitute -

" 126. A person shall not supply or consume or attempt to supply or consume or permit the supply or consumption of intoxicating liquor on any premises of any club in respect of which there is in force a club licence otherwise than -

(a) on any weekday, for any period between 10.00 a.m. and 12 midnight;

(b) on any Sunday, Christmas Day and Good Friday, during any period of 8 hours or periods amounting in all to 8 hours between 12 noon and 11.00 p.m.;

such period or periods to be regulated by and included in the rules of the club subject to the approval of the Royal Court."

Increased penalties.

4. In the principal Ordinance -
- (a) for "five hundred pounds" in section 148 and 149, substitute "level 5 on the uniform scale";
 - (b) for "one hundred pounds" in section 150, substitute "level 3 on the uniform scale";
 - (c) in section 145(2) for "a reference in the said Column 2 or 3 to a sum of money gives the maximum fine which may be imposed", substitute "references in the said Column 2 or 3 are to the maximum levels of fines that may be imposed in accordance with the Uniform Scale of Fines (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1989(d)";
 - (d) for the Fourth Schedule, substitute -

5. The penalties increased by virtue of section 4 shall only apply in relation to offences committed after the date of coming into force of this Ordinance.
