### **The Liquor Licensing (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1993**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of 31st March, 1993(a), hereby order:-

#### **Modification of Ordinance of 1984**

1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1984(b), as amended(c) ("the principal Ordinance"), it shall be lawful for licensed premises (other than those where only a General Off-Licence is in force) to open for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor on Liberation Day, Sunday May 9th, 1993, as if that day were a weekday, save that the permitted hours for all such premises shall be between 12 Noon and 11.00 p.m.

(2) The principal Ordinance shall apply in all other respects save as necessary to give effect to the provisions of sub-section (1) above.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1993.
