The Liquor Licensing (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1993

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of 31st March, 1993^a, hereby order: –

Modification of Ordinance of 1984.

1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1984^b, as amended^c ("the principal Ordinance"), it shall be lawful for licensed premises (other than those where only a General Off-Licence is in force) to open for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor on Liberation Day, Sunday May 9th, 1993, as if that day were a weekday, save that the permitted hours for all such premises shall be between 12 Noon and 11.00 p.m.

(2) The principal Ordinance shall apply in all other respects save as necessary to give effect to the provisions of sub-section (1) above.

NOTES

The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1984 has since been repealed by the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1993, section 113, with effect from 29th September, 1993.

The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1993 has since been repealed by the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006, section 102(a), with effect from 1st June, 2006, subject to the provisions of section 94 and section 95 of the 2006 Ordinance.
