The Liquor Licensing (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 9th day of December, 1998^a, hereby order: –

Modification of Ordinance of 1993.

1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1993, as amended^b, ("**the principal Ordinance**") it shall be lawful for licensed premises (other than those where only a General Off-Licence is in force) to open for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor on Liberation Day, Sunday, 9th May, 1999, as if that day were a weekday, save that the permitted hours for all such premises shall be between 12 noon on that day and 12.45 a.m. on Monday, 10th May, 1999.

(2) The principal Ordinance shall apply in all other respects save as necessary to give effect to the provisions of subsection (1).

NOTE

The Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 1993 has since been repealed by the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006, section 102(a), with effect from 1st June, 2006, subject to the provisions of section 94 and section 95 of the 2006 Ordinance.

Interpretation.

2. Expressions used in this Ordinance shall have the same meaning as in

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1999.
