Ordinance of the States. **XXX**
1950

Made 8th November, 1950
Coming into Operation 1st December, 1950

**The Live Poultry Importation Ordinance,
1950.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, hereby order:—

1. A person shall not, without a licence in that behalf from the Committee, import or attempt to import into this Island any live poultry other than poultry directly imported from the Island of Jersey or from another Island of this Bailiwick.
2. For the purpose of preventing the introduction or spread of disease, the Committee may refuse to grant a licence under the last preceding section or may attach to the grant thereof such conditions as they may think fit, and may at any time vary such conditions or any of them. They may further at any time revoke any licence granted by them.

3. The Committee may at any time by order published in La Gazette Officielle prohibit, restrict or impose conditions on the importation of live poultry into this Island from the Island of Jersey or from the other Islands of this Bailiwick or any of them and may from time to time revoke or vary the terms of such order.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Ordinance or of any order made hereunder, or who, having been granted an import licence thereunder, infringes any conditions attached to the grant of that licence, shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds, and the Court may, in addition thereto, order the destruction, at the expense of the convicted person, of any poultry to which the conviction relates, or the disposal by sale or otherwise of such poultry for the benefit of the States.
5. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the expression "poultry" shall mean domestic fowls, turkeys, geese, ducks and guinea-fowls, and the expression "the Committee" shall mean the States of Guernsey Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries.
6. 7. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1950.
