### **The Maintenance and Affiliation Orders (Maximum Weekly Payments) Ordinance, 1975**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Articles one and three of the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Séparation de Mariés en Police Correctionnelle" registered on the twenty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and thirty, as amended(a), section two of the Maintenance and Affiliation Orders (Amendment) Law, 1955, as amended(b), and Articles two and five of the Law entitled "Loi relative à l'Entretien des Enfants Illégitimes, 1927" registered on the fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended(c), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, hereby order:—

Maximum weekly payments under the Separation Law.

1. (1) The maximum weekly sum referred to in paragraph (c) (which relates to payments by the husband to the wife) of Article one of the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Séparation de Mariés en Police Correctionnelle" registered on the twenty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and thirty, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Separation Law"), which a husband may be ordered to pay to the wife or for her use shall be forty pounds.

(2) The maximum weekly sum referred to in paragraph (c) of Article three of the Separation Law which a husband may be ordered to pay to the wife or for her use shall be forty pounds.

Maximum weekly payment under the Law of 1955.

2. The maximum weekly sum referred to in subsection (1) of section two of the Maintenance and Affiliation Orders (Amendment) Law, 1955, as amended, which a husband may be ordered to pay for the maintenance of a child of the marriage shall be twelve pounds.

Maximum weekly payments under the Illegitimacy Law.

3. (1) The maximum weekly sum referred to in Article two of the Law entitled "Loi relative à l'Entretien des Enfants Illégitimes, 1927" registered on the fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Illegitimacy Law"), which a putative father of an illegitimate child may be ordered to pay for the maintenance of that child shall be twelve pounds.

(2) The maximum weekly sum referred to in Article five of the Illegitimacy Law which a putative father of an illegitimate child may be ordered to pay towards the relief of that child shall be twelve pounds.
