The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1957.

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in pursuance of section ten of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955, hereby order:—

1. Those parts of Her Majesty's dominions specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby declared to be reciprocating countries for the purposes of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955.

2. Section three of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries)

(Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1957, is hereby repealed.

3. The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1955 to 1956, the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1957, and this Ordinance may be cited together as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1955 to 1957.
