The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958.

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in pursuance of section ten of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955, hereby order:—

1. Western Australia is hereby declared to be a reciprocating country for the purposes of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955.
2. This Ordinance and the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1955 to 1957, may be cited together as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1955 to 1958.
