The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in pursuance of section ten of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955, hereby order:—

1. Those parts of Her Majesty's dominions specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby declared to be reciprocating countries for the purposes of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955. Reciprocating countries.

2. The words "The Colony and Protectorate of Nigeria and the Southern Cameroons" in the Schedule to the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Repeal.

Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 3) Ordinance, 1957, are hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance and the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1955 to 1958, may be cited together as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1955 to 1959.
