The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in pursuance of section ten of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), hereby order:—

1. The State of Tasmania is hereby declared to be a reciprocating country for the purposes of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955. State of Tasmania declared a reciprocating country.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974. Citation.
