**The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for
Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1955.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory Council and in pursuance of section ten of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955, hereby order:—

1. England, Wales, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man and the Island of Jersey are hereby declared to be reciprocating countries for the purposes of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955.

2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.
