The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in pursuance of section ten of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955, hereby order:—

1. The Colony of Seychelles is hereby declared to be a reciprocating country for the purposes of the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Guernsey) Law, 1955. Colony of Seychelles declared a reciprocating country.
2. This Ordinance and the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1959 and 1960, may be cited together as the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) (Reciprocating Countries) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1959 to 1961. Citation.
