THE MARRIAGE (RESIDENCE QUALIFICATION) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE 2008

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the *(a) and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by article 14(a) of the Loi ayant rapport aux Mariages Célébrés dans l'Île d'Auregny(b) hereby order:-

1. The period of residence for the purpose of article 14(a) of the Marriage Law is a period of at least 3 days and article 14 shall be construed as if the reference in that article to a period of at least a month were a reference to a period of at least 3 days.

Period of residence for purposes of marriage by special licence.

2. (1) In this Ordinance "the Marriage Law" means the Loi ayant rapport aux Mariages Célébrés dans l'Île d'Auregny, as amended(b)

Interpretation.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance as they apply to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
