**The Matrimonial Causes (Poor Persons)  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee and in exercise of the powers now vested in them by Article seven of the Matrimonial Causes Law (Guernsey), 1939(a), hereby order:—

1. The Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Matrimonial Causes (Poor Persons) Ordinance, 1952(b), are hereby amended as follows:— Amend-

- (a) in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of Regulation two thereof the words “five pounds” are repealed and the words “fourteen pounds” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (a) of Regulation four thereof the words “five pounds” are repealed and the words “ten pounds” are substituted therefor;

(c) in sub-paragraph (i) and in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (b) of Regulation four thereof the words "two pounds" wherever those words occur are repealed and the words "four pounds" are substituted therefor.

Citation.       2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Matrimonial Causes (Poor Persons) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971.

Collective title.   3. This Ordinance and the Matrimonial Causes (Poor Persons) Ordinance, 1952, may be cited together as the Matrimonial Causes (Poor Persons) Ordinances, 1952 and 1971.
