**The May and August Bank Holidays
Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. The last Monday in the month of May in each of the years nineteen hundred and seventy-three and nineteen hundred and seventy-four, shall be a bank holiday instead of the Monday in Whitsun Week in each of those years. Last Monday in May, 1973 and 1974 to be bank holidays.
2. The last Monday in the month of August in each of the years nineteen hundred and seventy-two, nineteen hundred and seventy-three and nineteen hundred and seventy-four, shall be a bank holiday instead of the first Monday in that month in each of those years. Last Monday in August, 1972, 1973 and 1974 to be bank holidays.

Reference to Monday in Whitsun Week and the first Monday in August to be construed, as respects certain years, as reference to the last Monday in May and the last Monday in August respectively.

3. The reference in section two of the Bank Holidays and Negotiable Instruments (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1955(a), to the Monday in Whitsun Week shall be construed, as respects each of the years nineteen hundred and seventy-three and nineteen hundred and seventy-four, as a reference to the last Monday in the month of May in each of those years and the reference in that Ordinance to the first Monday in the month of August shall be construed, as respects each of the years nineteen hundred and seventy-two, nineteen hundred and seventy-three and nineteen hundred and seventy-four, as a reference to the last Monday in the month of August in each of those years.

Repeal.

4. The August Bank Holiday Ordinance, 1971(b), is hereby repealed.

Extent.

5. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

6. This Ordinance may be cited as the May and August Bank Holidays Ordinance, 1972.
