### **The May Bank Holiday Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), and in pursuance of the Resolution of the States of the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. The last Monday in the month of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, shall be a bank holiday instead of the Monday in Whitsun Week in that year. Last Monday in May, 1972, to be a bank holiday.

Reference to Monday in Whitsun Week to be construed, as respects 1972, as a reference to last Monday in May.

2. The reference in section two of the Bank Holidays and Negotiable Instruments (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1955(b), to the Monday in Whitsun Week shall be construed, as respects the year nineteen hundred and seventy-two, as a reference to the last Monday in the month of May.

Extent.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the May Bank Holiday Ordinance, 1972.
