**The Mental Treatment (General)  
(Regulations) (Amendment) Ordinance,  
1964**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers now vested in them under Article 3 and Article 46 of the Mental Treatment Law (Guernsey) 1939(a), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. The Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Mental Treatment (General) (Regulations) Ordinance, 1956(b), are hereby amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) the expression “Medical Superintendent”, wherever it occurs therein, is hereby repealed and the expression “Consultant Psychiatrist” is hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) Regulation one thereof is hereby repealed;
- (c) in paragraph (1) of Regulation two thereof, the words “and to the powers vested in him

- under the provisions of Regulation one of these Regulations" are hereby repealed;
- (d) in sub-paragraph (e) of paragraph (3) of Regulation two thereof, the words "by him" are hereby repealed;
  - (e) paragraph (4), paragraph (5), paragraph (6) and paragraph (11) of Regulation two thereof are hereby repealed;
  - (f) Regulation three thereof is hereby repealed;
  - (g) paragraph (2) of Regulation five thereof is hereby repealed;
  - (h) in paragraph (3) of Regulation five thereof, the words "the Medical Superintendent and" are hereby repealed;
  - (i) in paragraph (4) of Regulation five thereof, the words "and the Medical Superintendent" are hereby repealed and the words "to the Medical Superintendent" are hereby repealed and the words "to the Board" are hereby substituted therefor;
  - (j) in paragraph (5) of Regulation five thereof, the words and commas "Either the Matron or a nurse appointed by her in that behalf, with the approval of the Medical Superintendent," are hereby repealed and the words "A nurse appointed by the Matron" are hereby substituted therefor and the words "to the Medical Superintendent" are hereby repealed and the words "to the Matron" are hereby substituted therefor;
  - (k) in paragraph (6) of Regulation five thereof, the words "the Medical Superintendent and" are hereby repealed;
  - (l) paragraphs (9) to (15), inclusive, of Regulation five thereof are hereby repealed;

(m) in Regulation twelve thereof—

- (i) in the definition of the expression “the Board”, immediately after the words “the States Board of Health”, there are hereby inserted the words “and includes a Committee of the States Board of Health”;
- (ii) the definition of the expression “Medical Superintendent” is hereby repealed and the following definition is hereby substituted therefor—  
 ““Consultant Psychiatrist” has the meaning assigned to it by Article 1 of the Law;”.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Mental Treatment (General) (Regulations) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and this Ordinance and the Mental Treatment (General) (Regulations) Ordinance, 1956, may be cited together as the Mental Treatment (General) (Regulations) Ordinances, 1956 and 1964. Citation and commencement.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.
