**The Milk (Contributions from Milk
Producers) Ordinance, 1964**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two and section eight of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), as amended by the Milk and Milk Products (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1963(b), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say—
- “the Agriculture Committee” means the States Committee for Agriculture;

“approved scheme” means any scheme for the time being approved by the States by Resolution and designed to encourage the adoption of improved techniques in the milk producing industry;

“Dairy Committee” means the States Dairy Committee;

“farmer” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section two of the principal Ordinance;

“the fund” means the fund established by the States and administered and controlled by the Agriculture Committee under and in accordance with any approved scheme;

“obtain” includes offer or agree or attempt to obtain;

“pot” means four pints;

“the principal Ordinance” means the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958(c), as amended.

Contributions from milk producers.

2. (1) A contribution to the fund shall be payable by every farmer at the rate of one farthing per pot of milk in respect of all milk delivered by him to the Dairy Committee on and after the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, which is classified as Grade 1 milk under the provisions of the principal Ordinance and which is not surplus to the Island's milk requirements.

(2) The Dairy Committee shall, at such times as it deems proper, retain out of any sum payable to any farmer under the provisions of the principal Ordinance in respect of milk delivered by him to

the Dairy Committee any amount which may be payable by that farmer by way of contribution to the fund under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section and shall, as soon as may be, remit such amount to the Agriculture Committee for payment into the fund.

(3) Any moneys remitted by the Dairy Committee to the Agriculture Committee under the provisions of the last preceding subsection in respect of the contribution to the fund payable by any farmer under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have been paid by that farmer and upon being so remitted shall become the absolute property of the States.

(4) For the purposes of subsection (4) of section six of the principal Ordinance, any moneys remitted by the Dairy Committee to the Agriculture Committee under the provisions of subsection (2) of this section in respect of the contribution to the fund payable by any farmer under the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have been paid by the Dairy Committee to that farmer.

4. (1) A person shall not, with intent to deceive— False statements, etc.
- (a) produce, furnish, send or otherwise make use of, for the purposes of any approved scheme, any book, account, estimate, return, declaration or other document which is false in a material particular; or
 - (b) obtain or represent himself as entitled to receive any payment out of the fund under any approved scheme.

(2) A person shall not, in furnishing any information for the purposes of any approved scheme, make any statement which he knows to be false in

a material particular or recklessly make any statement which is false in a material particular.

(3) A person who contravenes or attempts to contravene any of the provisions of subsection (1) or subsection (2) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such imprisonment and such fine.

Citation.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Contributions from Milk Producers) Ordinance, 1964.
