The Milk (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1964

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. The Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended(b) (hereafter in this Ordinance referred to as “the principal Ordinance”), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) subsection (2) of section six thereof is hereby repealed and the following two subsections are hereby substituted therefor—

“(2) Subject to the provisions of this section, during the twelve months commencing on the first day of July in any year (hereafter in this section referred to as “the prescribed period”) the price per pot fixed by the Committee as aforesaid for Grade 1 milk so delivered to the Committee during that period which is not surplus to the Island’s milk requirements shall be such price per pot (hereafter in this section referred to as “the standard price”) as shall have been approved by the States by Resolution in respect of that period on the recommendation of the States Committee for Agriculture.

(2A) During any period within the two months next following the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, the price per pot fixed by the Committee as aforesaid for Grade 1 milk so delivered to the Committee during that period which is not surplus to the Island’s milk requirements shall be such price per pot as shall have been approved by the States by Resolution in respect of that period on the recommendation of the States Committee for Agriculture.”;

- (b) in paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section twenty-two thereof there are hereby inserted, immediately before the word “obtain”, the words “with intent to deceive”;
- (c) in subsection (3) of section twenty-seven thereof the word “May” is hereby repealed and the word “July” is hereby substituted therefor.

2. Subsection (4) of section seven of the principal Ordinance and the Milk (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1963, are hereby repealed. Repeals.

3. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section six of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, any order made by the States Dairy Committee under that section which was in force immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance shall continue to have effect on and after the commencement of this Ordinance in all respects as if this Ordinance had not been passed. Saving.

(2) The provisions of subsection (4) of section six of the principal Ordinance shall continue to have effect as respects the twelve months commencing on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, in all respects as if this Ordinance had not been passed.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1964, and this Ordinance and the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1958 and 1962, may be cited together as the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1958 to 1964. Citation.
