**The Milk (Control) (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law, 1955, as amended (a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-three, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after section six of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended (b), there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered “6A”—

“Reduction in the price payable to a farmer during accounting periods when milk is classified as Grade 2 or Grade 3.

6A. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Ordinance and for the purpose of discouraging the production of milk of inferior grades, where during any accounting period any milk delivered by a farmer in pursuance of the provisions of section two of this Ordinance is classified as either Grade 2 milk or Grade 3 milk (in this section referred to as “inferior grading”) then, the price which, but for the provisions of this section would be payable by the Committee to the farmer in accordance with the provisions of section six of this Ordinance, shall, in respect of all the milk so delivered by that farmer at any time during that accounting period before and after the inferior grading occurred, be reduced to the extent, if any, set out as follows:—

- (a) where the inferior grading occurred during any accounting period immediately following an accounting period in which no inferior grading occurred, there shall be no reduction in the price payable;
- (b) where the inferior grading occurred during any accounting period immediately following an

accounting period in which any inferior grading occurred, there shall be a reduction of twelve and one-half per centum in the price otherwise payable;

(c) where the inferior grading occurred during any accounting period immediately following two successive accounting periods in which, as regards each such accounting period, any inferior grading occurred, there shall be a reduction of twenty-five per centum in the price otherwise payable;

(d) where the inferior grading occurred during any accounting period immediately following three successive accounting periods in which, as regards each such accounting period, any inferior grading occurred, there shall be a reduction of fifty per centum in the price otherwise payable.

(2) For the purposes of this section—

(a) where any inferior grading first occurs during any

accounting period immediately following any successive accounting periods amounting to a continuous period of six months or more in which no inferior grading occurred, then no inferior grading shall be deemed to have occurred during that first accounting period; and

- (b) where any inferior grading occurs on the last day of any accounting period, then that inferior grading shall be deemed to have occurred on the first day of the accounting period immediately following.

(3) In this section the expression "accounting period" means such period, not exceeding one month, as the Committee may, from time to time, by order prescribe."

Repeal.

2. Section three of the Milk (Control) (Increase in Fines) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983(c), is hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983.

4. This Ordinance, the Milk (Control) (Increase in Fines) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983, and the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1958 to 1980, may be cited together as the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1958 to 1983. ^{Collective title.}

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of August, nineteen hundred and eighty-three. ^{Commencement.}
