The Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1967

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two and section eight of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. (1) No person shall buy or obtain, otherwise than from the Committee or from a person licensed under Part IV of the Milk Control (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958(b), to sell milk by retail, milk which has not been produced in this Island.

(2) No person except the Committee shall sell or supply to any retailer milk which has not been produced in this Island.

(3) A person who contravenes or attempts to contravene the provisions of subsection (1) or sub-

section (2) of this section shall be guilty of an offence under this Ordinance.

Citation and construction.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1967, and this Ordinance and the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1958 to 1966(c), may be cited together as the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1958 to 1967.

(2) This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended.
