ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 7th October, 1987
Coming into force 11th October, 1987

THE MILK (RETAIL PRICE) ORDINANCE, 1987

THE STATES, in pursuance of their resolution of the 7th day of October, 1987 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2(1)(d) of the Milk and Milk Products (Alderney) Law, 1957(a) hereby order:-

Maximum retail price of milk.

1. A person shall not buy or sell milk by retail –
 - (a) at the States Dairy, at a price in excess of 29 new pence per pint;
 - (b) elsewhere in the Island, at a price in excess of 30 new pence per pint.

Offence.

2. A person who contravenes this Ordinance is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding £200.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Retail Price) Ordinance, 1987.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on 11th October, 1987.
