ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 3rd April, 1991
Coming into force 7th April, 1991

THE MILK (RETAIL PRICE) ORDINANCE, 1991

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 3rd day of April, 1991, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 2(1)(a), 2(1)(d) and 8 of the Milk and Milk Products (Alderney) Law, 1957(a), hereby order:-

Maximum price

1. A person shall not buy or sell milk by retail in the Island at a price in excess of:
 - (a) 42 new pence per pint, if the milk is sold by imperial measure: or
 - (b) 42 new pence per ½ litre (500 mls) if the milk is sold by metric measure.

Offence

2. A person who contravenes this Ordinance is guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the Alderney uniform scale.

Repeal

3. The Milk (Retail Price) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1990 is repealed.

Citation

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Retail Price) Ordinance, 1991.

Commencement

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 7th day of April, 1991.
