THE MILK (RETAIL PRICE) ORDINANCE, 1993

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the second day of June, 1993, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 2(1)(a), 2(1)(d) and 8 of the Milk and Milk Products (Alderney) Law, 1957 (a), hereby order:—

1. A person shall not buy or sell milk by retail in the Island at a **Maximum price** price in excess of:

(a) 47 new pence per pint, if the milk is sold by imperial measure; or

(b) 47 new pence per 1/2 litre (500 mls) if the milk is sold by metric measure.

2. A person who contravenes this Ordinance is guilty of an **Offence** offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the Alderney uniform scale.

3. The Milk (Retail Price) Ordinance 1992 is repealed. **Repeal**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Milk (Retail Price) **Citation** Ordinance, 1993.

Commencement 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twentieth day of June, 1993.
