**The Inflammable Oils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1994**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30th day of September, 1993(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Huiles ou Essences Minérales ou autres substances de la même nature, 1924", as amended(b), hereby order:-

**Amendment to Ordinance of 1925.**

1. In the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Huiles ou Essences Minérales ou autres substances de la même nature" made on the 23rd May, 1925, as amended(c)-

(a) for section 2 substitute-

"2. Every importer of inflammable oils shall, not less than 24 hours before the arrival of a consignment of such oils, notify the Board and

provide such information and documentation in relation to the consignment as the Board may require.";

- (b) in section 4 for the words "under the supervision of" substitute "with the permission of and in accordance with any conditions or directions imposed by";
- (c) in section 5 for the words following "by means of pumps through pipes" substitute "with the permission of and in accordance with any conditions or directions imposed by the Inspector";
- (d) in section 7(15)(b) the words "of Administration" wherever appearing are repealed;
- (e) in section 8 the words "in quantities not exceeding 10,000 gallons" and "of Administration" are repealed;
- (f) section 9 is repealed;
- (g) in section 10(1)(b) for the words "in such manner" substitute "with the permission of the Inspector";
- (h) for section 10(2) substitute-
  - "(2) The Board may issue licences for the storage of inflammable oils in such form and subject to such conditions as it thinks fit.";
- (i) in section 10(4)-
  - (i) after the word "license" insert "or permission or of any regulation or direction of the Inspector or the Harbour Master"; and

- (ii) for "£10" substitute "level 5 on the uniform scale"; and
- (j) the Schedule is repealed.

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Inflammable Oils (Amendment) Ordinance, 1994.

**Commencement.**

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st November, 1994.
