**The Passenger Boats (Guernsey)
Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-five, hereby order:—

1. The Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance par rapport aux Bateaux portant Passagers, ou mis en location” made permanent on the eighteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-two^(a), is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) in section two thereof the words “le Supérieur des Etats” are repealed and the words “le Conseil Administratif des Etats (ci-après dit “le Conseil”)” are substituted therefor;

- (b) in section three thereof the words "Administratif des Etats (ci-après dit "le Conseil")" are repealed;
- (c) in section four thereof the words "Superviseur des Etats pour une licence pour tel bateau et de verser au même temps entre les mains du dit Superviseur des Etats" are repealed and the words "Conseil pour une licence pour tel bateau et de payer au même temps au Conseil" are substituted therefor.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Passenger Boats (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970.

Commencement.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the second day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy.
