**The Passenger Vessels (Amendment)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-five, and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them by sections seventy-one and seventy-two of the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Marine Marchande dans le Bailliage de l'Île de Guernesey", registered on the sixth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixteen^(a), hereby order:—

1. The Passenger Vessels (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance")^(b) is hereby amended as follows:—

“ “the Board” means the States Board of Administration;”;

- (b) in section three and section six thereof the words “the Supervisor” where those words occur are repealed and the words “the Board” are substituted therefor;
- (c) in section three and in subsection (3) of section six thereof the word “he” where that word occurs is repealed and the word “it” is substituted therefor.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Passenger Vessels (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Passenger Vessels (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinances, 1953 and 1970.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the second day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy.
