The Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1964

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE,
in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by
paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform
(Guernsey) Law, 1948, and on the representations of
the States Board of Health, hereby order:—

1. The Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1959, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) in subsection (2) of section thirteen thereof
the words "A person shall not sell or supply

monofluoroacetic acid or any salt thereof” are hereby repealed and the words “A person shall not sell or supply any substance to which this subsection applies” are hereby substituted therefor;

(b) in the Proviso to subsection (2) of section thirteen thereof the words “monofluoroacetic acid or a salt thereof”—

(i) where those words first occur and in paragraph (c) are hereby repealed and the words “a substance to which this subsection applies” are hereby substituted therefor,

(ii) in paragraph (d) are hereby repealed and the words “a substance to which this subsection applies named in the certificate” are hereby substituted therefor;

(c) immediately after subsection (2) of section thirteen thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(2A)”—

“(2A) The last preceding subsection applies to monofluoroacetic acid, any salt thereof, fluoroacetamide and fluoroacetanilide.”;

(d) in the First Schedule thereto, in the item beginning with the words “Fluoroacetamide; fluoroacetanilide” all the words after the word “fluoroacetanilide” where that word first occurs are hereby repealed;

(e) in the Third Schedule thereto, in the Part headed “Group II” in the first column the item “Fluoroacetamide; fluoroacetanilide” and the entry opposite thereto in the second column are hereby repealed;

- (f) in the Fifth Schedule thereto in the entry in the second column opposite to the item "Fluoroacetamide; fluoroacetanilide" in the first column, the words "Preparations for use in agriculture or horticulture" are hereby repealed;
- (g) the Thirteenth Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1964, and this Ordinance and the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1959 and 1962, may be cited together as the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1959 to 1964.

Citation and collective title.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Herm.
