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**The Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1973****(No. LIII
—1973)**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Health, hereby order:—

1. The Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy Ordinance, 1970, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) immediately after subsection (8A) of section fifteen thereof there are inserted the following additional subsections numbered “(8B)”, “(8C)” and “(8D)”—

“(8B) A person shall not sell or supply cannabinol or its tetrahydro derivatives, prepared wholly or partly by synthesis, their 3-alkyl homologues, or any ester or ether of the aforementioned substances:

Provided that this subsection shall not apply to the sale or supply of a substance to which this subsection applies—

- (a) to the States Analyst for the purposes of his functions as such; or
- (b) to a person in charge of a laboratory used for scientific education or research or chemical analysis, and attached to a hospital maintained by the Board, for the purposes of that education, research or analysis.

(8C) A person shall not sell or supply calcium cyanide, potassium cyanide or sodium cyanide:

Provided that this subsection shall not apply to the sale or supply of a substance to which this subsection applies—

(a) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XVI, p. 236; Tome XVII, p. 121; and Ordinance No. XXIV of 1973.

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- (a) by way of wholesale dealing; or
- (b) to an authorised medical practitioner, an authorised dentist or an authorised veterinary surgeon for the purposes of his profession as such; or
- (c) for use in connection with any hospital, infirmary, dispensary or similar institution approved by an order, whether general or specific, of the Board; or
- (d) to a person or institution concerned with scientific education or research for the purposes of that education or research.

(8D) A person shall not sell or supply thallium sulphate:

Provided that this subsection shall not apply to the sale or supply of thallium sulphate—

- (a) by way of wholesale dealing; or
- (b) to a person in charge of a laboratory used for scientific education or research or chemical analysis for the purposes of that education, research or analysis; or
- (c) to an employee of the States of Guernsey for the purpose of public service as such; or
- (d) to a person producing a written authority in form "C" of the forms set out in the Thirteenth Schedule to this Ordinance issued within the preceding twelve months by the Medical Officer of Health authorising the purchase of thallium sulphate for use by such person or by the employees of such body of persons as is named in the authority for the purpose of killing rats, mice or moles in the course of a business of pest control"

(b) in subsection (1) of section seventeen thereof—

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(i) sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) thereof is repealed and the following sub-paragraph is substituted therefor—

“(ii) the name which appears, in the list published under section one hundred of the Medicines Act 1968, as the approved name of the poison; or”;

(ii) sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (b) thereof is repealed and the following sub-paragraph is substituted therefor—

“(ii) in any other case, the accepted scientific name, the name descriptive of the true nature and origin of the poison or the name which appears, in the list published under section one hundred of the Medicines Act 1968, as the approved name of the poison.”;

(c) in subsection (1) of section thirty-two thereof the words “, other than sulphur,” are repealed;

(d) in section thirty-three thereof the words “Part II of” are repealed;

(e) in subsection (1) of section forty-two thereof the full stop at the end of the definition of the expression “the Royal Court” is deleted and a semi-colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there is inserted the following additional definition—

“the States Analyst” means the States Analyst for the time being appointed by the States Civil Service Board and includes any Analyst acting by or

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under the authority of the States Analyst.;

(f) in the First Schedule thereto—

(ii) the entry relating to the item “Arsenical poisons” is deleted and the entry—

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- (a) substances containing less than 0.022 per cent. of arsanilic acid and not containing any other arsenical poison;
- (b) (i) poultry feeding stuffs containing not more than 0.0375 per cent. of carbarsone and not containing any other arsenical poison, and
(ii) any other substances containing less than 0.0263 per cent. of carbarsone and not containing any other arsenical poison;
- (c) substances containing less than 0.0133 per cent. of 4-hydroxy-3-nitro-phenylarsonic acid and not containing any other arsenical poison;
- (d) dentrifrices containing less than 0.5 per cent. of acetarsol;
- (e) other substances containing less than the equivalent of 0.0075 per cent. of arsenic (As)”
is substituted therefor;
- (iii) the entry relating to the item “Diphenoxylate” is deleted and the entry—
“Diphenoxylate; its salts; except preparations containing, per dosage unit, not more than 2.5 milligrammes of diphenoxylate calculated as base and not less than twenty-five microgrammes of atropine sulphate”
is substituted therefor;
- (iv) in the entry relating to the item “Phosphorus compounds” the following items are inserted at the appropriate points therein in alphabetical order:—

(g) in Group II of the Third Schedule thereto—

- (ii) in the second column thereof in the entry relating to the item “ Jaborandi ” under the heading “ Alkaloids ” a semi-colon is inserted at the end of the entry and immediately thereafter the words “ preparations containing not more than two per cent., weight in weight, of the sulphate salt of *trans*-pilosine ” are inserted;
- (iii) in the second column thereof in the entry relating to the item “ Arsenical poisons ” a semi-colon is inserted at the end of the entry and immediately thereafter the words “ poultry feeding stuffs containing not more than 0.0375 per cent of carbarsonne and not containing any other arsenical poison; liquid preparations intended for agricultural use containing not more than 0.9 per cent. of anhydrous sodium arsanilate ” are inserted;
- (iv) in the second column thereof in the entry relating to the item “ Phenols ” the following entry is inserted at the

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“liquid disinfectants or antiseptics not containing phenol and containing less than 2.5 per cent. of other phenols”;

- (v) in the first column thereof all the items included under the heading “Phosphorus compounds” and the entries opposite thereto in the second column thereof are deleted and the items set out in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance and the entries set out opposite thereto in the second column thereof are respectively substituted therefor;
- (vi) in the second column thereof in the entry relating to the item “Sodium fluoride” a semi-colon is inserted at the end of the entry and immediately thereafter the words “tablets containing not more than 0.016 per cent., weight in weight, of sodium fluoride and intended, when chewed, to prevent tooth decay” are inserted;

- Repeal. 2. Subsection (2) of section two of the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, is hereby repealed.
- Extent. 3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Herm.
- Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1973.
- Collective title. 5. This Ordinance, the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, and the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy Ordinances, 1970 and 1971, may be cited together as the Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy Ordinances, 1970 to 1973.
