**The Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Health, hereby order:—

1. The Pharmacists, Poisons and Pharmacy Ordinance, 1970, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) (a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in paragraph (e) of subsection (6) of section nine thereof immediately after the word “again” there are inserted the words “and of a medical prescription”;
- (b) in subsection (1) of section forty-two thereof immediately after the definition of the expression “legal disability” there is inserted the following additional definition—

““medical prescription” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (2) of section five of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972;”.
