**The Places of Recreation (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1966**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration, hereby order:—

1. In the Schedule to the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative à la Police des Lieux de Récréation” of the fourth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-nine^(a) as amended^(b), immediately before the reference to “Delancey Park, Saint Sampson’s” there is hereby inserted a reference to the following place:—
