The Places of Recreation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1996.

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30th day of May, 1996(a), hereby order:-

Amendment of 1975 Ordinance.

1. In the Places of Recreation Ordinance, 1975(b)-
 - (a) in section 1(a)(i) the words "elsewhere than on a roadway or on a place set aside as a parking place" are repealed;
 - (b) in section 1(a)(ii), (iv) and (v) after the word "permission" insert "in writing";
 - (c) in sections 1 and 3 for the words following "and liable, on conviction," substitute "to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the uniform scale";
 - (d) after section 1 insert the following section-

(a) Article IV of Billet d'État No. X of 1996.

(b) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XX, p. 139.

"Power to make orders.

1A. (1) The Board of Administration may by order amend the provisions of the Schedule to this Ordinance.

- (2) An order of the Board under this section-
 - (a) may be amended or repealed by a subsequent order hereunder;
 - (b) may contain such consequential, incidental, supplemental and transitional provision as may appear to the Board to be necessary or expedient;
 - (c) shall be laid before a meeting of the States as soon as possible and shall, if at that or the next meeting the States resolve to annul it, cease to have effect, but without prejudice to anything done under it or to the making of a new order;
 - (d) shall not come into force until published in La Gazette Officielle."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Places of Recreation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1996.
