**The Plant Protection (Transfer of
Functions) Ordinance, 1957.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 31st day of October, 1956, hereby order:—

1. (1) The functions and powers vested in the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries under and by virtue of the provisions of—

- (a) the Potatoes (Wart Disease) Ordinance, 1950,
- (b) the Plants and Potatoes Importation Ordinances, 1951 and 1953, and
- (c) the Colorado Beetle (Export of Potatoes) Ordinance, 1952,

are hereby transferred to and vested in the States Committee for Horticulture.

(2) In addition to the functions and powers transferred and vested under the provisions of the

preceding subsection there are also hereby so transferred and vested all rights and liabilities enjoyed by, or incumbent on, the said Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries in, or as a result of, the exercise of those functions or powers.

2. (1) Nothing done by, or in relation to, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries under or as a consequence of the functions or powers transferred under the provisions of subsection (1) of the last preceding section before the coming into force of this Ordinance shall be invalidated by the coming into force thereof.

(2) Anything in process of being done under any of the provisions of the Ordinances referred to in section one of this Ordinance by, or in relation to, the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries at the time of the coming into force of this Ordinance, whether by way of legal proceedings or otherwise, may be continued by, or in relation to, the States Committee for Horticulture.
