**The Poisonous Substances (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1963**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950(a), and by section two and section eleven of the Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Law, 1958(b), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling and in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, hereby order:—

1. The Poisonous Substances Ordinance, 1962(c) Amendment of Ordinance of 1962.
(hereafter in this Ordinance referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) subsection (1) of section twenty-seven thereof is hereby repealed and the following two subsections are hereby substituted therefor—

“(1) Except with the permission of the Committee, which permission may be granted generally or in any particular case, any container in which any poisonous substance used or intended for use in agriculture has been kept shall not be used for any purpose other than for keeping therein any poisonous substance intended for use in agriculture.

(1A) In any case where the Committee has granted permission under subsection (1) of this section for any container such as is mentioned in that subsection to be used for any purpose other than for keeping therein any poisonous substance intended for use in agriculture, such container shall be so used subject to and in accordance with such conditions as the Committee may from time to time see fit to impose.”;

- (b) in Part II of the Second Schedule thereto, there shall be inserted—

- (i) in the second column thereof, immediately below the item “2-(1-methyl-n-propyl)-4, 6-dinitrophenol”, the words “The salts of the last-mentioned substance”;
- (ii) in the second column thereof, immediately below the item “2-methyl-4, 6-dinitrophenol”, the words “The salts of the last-mentioned substance”;

(iii) in the first column thereof, immediately below the reference to TEPP(HETP), the words "disulfoton" and "phorate", and opposite those words respectively, in the second column thereof, the items "diethyl S-[2-(ethylthio) ethyl] phosphorothiolothionate" and "diethyl S-(ethylthiomethyl) phosphorothiolothionate".

2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands Application. of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Poisonous Substances (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Poisonous Substances Ordinances, 1962 and 1963. Citation and commencement.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the sixteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
