**The Post Office (Amendment) (No. 2)
Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections thirteen, fifteen, twenty-three, twenty-four and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. (1) The Sixth and Tenth Schedules to the Post Office Ordinance, 1969, as amended^(b), are hereby repealed and the First and Second Schedules to this Ordinance are hereby respectively substituted therefor. Repeals.

(2) The Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) section twenty-nine thereof is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor—

“ 29. The First, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Seventh and Eighth Schedules to the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Sixth and Seventh Schedules to this Ordinance are hereby respectively substituted therefor.”;

- (b) the Fifth and Eighth Schedules thereto are repealed.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1972.

(2) This Ordinance, the Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972(c), and the Post Office Ordinances, 1969 and 1971, may be cited together as the Post Office Ordinances, 1969 to 1972.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
