## Ordinance of the States **XXX** 1969

Made ... .. 26th November, 1969.

### **The Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections twenty-four and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Section twenty-four of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as “the Law”) shall apply to all postal packets, other than postcards, which are posted in the Bailiwick for transmission to any place outside it or which are brought by post into the Bailiwick.

Postal packets to which section twenty-four of Law applies.

2. The Duty on Goods Law, 1953, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, shall not apply to goods contained in postal packets to which section twenty-four of the Law applies brought into or sent out of the Bailiwick by post from or to any place outside the Bailiwick.

Law of 1953 not to apply to postal packets.
