**The Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance,
1972**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Post Office Board, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections thirteen, twenty-three and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(*a*), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The word “Pakistan” in Part I of the Second Schedule to the Post Office Ordinance, 1969, as amended(*b*), is hereby repealed. Amend-

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972, and shall come into force on the first day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-two. Citation and
