The Post Office Board (Chief Executive) Ordinance, 1995

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Post Office Board and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1991(a), hereby order:-

Renaming of office of Director.

1. (1) In sections 11 and 71(1) of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969(b), for the words "States Director of Postal Services" substitute "Chief Executive of the States Post Office Board".

(2) Any reference in any enactment or statutory instrument, howsoever expressed, to the States Director of Postal Services shall be construed as a reference to the Chief Executive of the States Post Office Board.

Transitional and savings provisions.

2. (1) Anything done by or in relation to the States Director of Postal Services before the commencement of this Ordinance shall have effect as if done by or in relation to the Chief Executive of the States Post Office Board.

(2) Anything in the process of being done by or in relation to the States Director of Postal Services at the time of the commencement of this Ordinance may be continued by or in relation to the Chief Executive of the States Post Office Board.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Post Office Board (Chief Executive) Ordinance, 1995.
